I am vehemently opposed to your recent decision to designate the Mid Atlantic National Corridor. It is my position that your office has failed to adequately answer the issues raised by myself and other concerned citizens regarding these corridors.

I do not believe that your office has presented an adequate argument that shows the justification for usurping rights that have been traditionally afforded to individual states.
