A month or so ago, I accessed your web site to find my previous comments and I could not find mine. I wished then to expound up them, and am doing so now.

On or shortly before July 6, 2007, I sent you a message through the DOE web site opposing the designation of the Mid-Atlantic NEITC Corridor. I mentioned that such action was comparable to the tyrannical, dictatorial reign of George III from which we severed ourselves over 200 years ago.

Perhaps I need to expand upon that, as the NEITC designation was declared. In this message, I am an aggrieved party in Prince William County, Virginia requesting a new hearing.

The 2005 Energy Act called for consultation by DOE with the various states before designating any such corridors. As DOE has not included the various states in this designation process, it has violated the procedure set out in the legislation, and its actions in regard to this matter should be deemed invalid.

Further, I would like confirmation from DOE that these current comments were received as well as my previous comments. As your web site does not seem reliable, written notice sent via the postal service with receipt acknowledged would be preferred.
